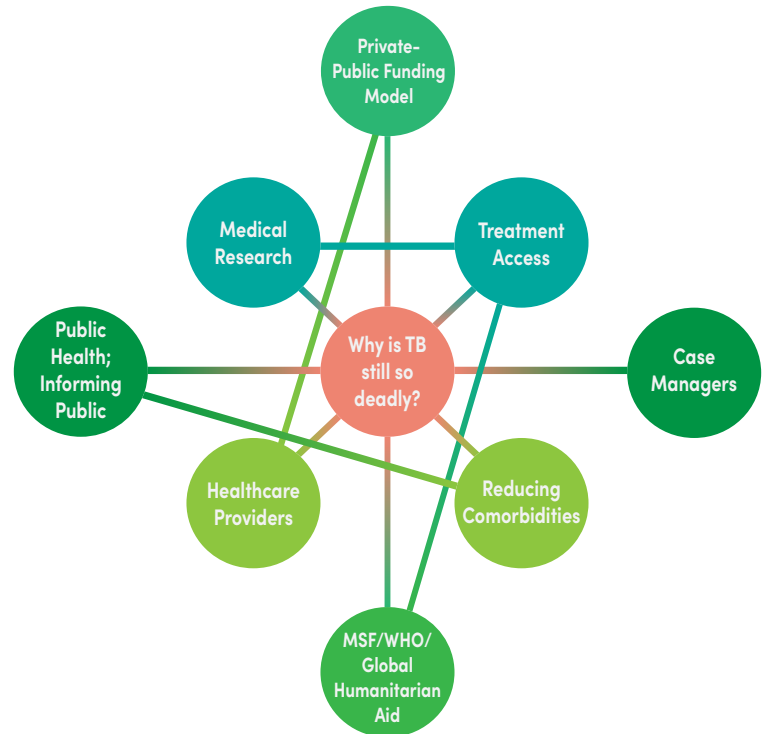

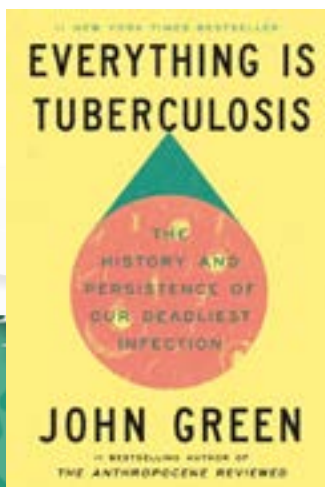
How and where can we begin a dialogue and take the first steps to address large, complex problems like ending tuberculosis?
